The DNGCD is composed of three Customs Coast Guard Services to ensure the strategic and operational management of the maritime and air resources of the customs administration.

Located on three maritime facades "Antilles-Guyana", "Channel-North Sea Atlantic" and the "Mediterranean", its maritime surveillance units are designed to prevent fraud of any kind perpetrated in violation of the provisions of France and the EU community customs codes.

The DNGCD is equipped with airplanes, helicopters, coastal and deepsea vessels connected to the customs land brigades and its intelligence center, and is recognized as a major actor of the Action of the State at Sea.

- Increase the visibility of the customs action, its capabilities and its aeromarine means.
